REGULAR MINUTES CONTINUED

Mrs. Klein gave the administrative report. Maurice Schlaht, Gregory Mayor, contacted the school concerning the Safe to School Grant. Discussion was held concerning continuing sidewalks leading to the school. The school will be involved in applying for this grant. Mrs. Klein reported on the Race to the Top Grant submitted by Mid Central Coop. Mrs. Klein reported that Eric Person, Burke Superintendent, contacted her concerning consolidation. Discussion was held Doug Pochop moved to attend a meeting with Burke and South Central for the purpose of discussing consolidation. Motion died for the lack of a second. Mrs. Klein gave the Mid Central report and handed out the superintendent evaluation form which will be due in January.

Jeff Determan gave the principal report. He reported that K-12 had a Veterans' Day Program. Winter sports are starting practice, Region Oral Interp is November 19th, and Region V Music Festival will be November 26th in Gregory. The ICU program (this program is to help students stay on track and get assignments completed) is now implemented 9th, 10th and 12 grades. Mr. Determan commented that this program is working out very well. December 3rd will be the MS/HS Holiday Concert.

Dave Shoemaker reported that snow removal bids were opened November 7 in the business office. Klein Construction bid \$70.00 per hour and Justin Vosika bid \$75.00 per hour. The bid was awarded to Klein Construction.

It was moved by Sinclair and seconded by Stukel to approve the 2011-12 Audit Report. Yes: All present. Motion carried.

Three bids for the freezer/cooler were opened. It was moved by Pochop and seconded by Stukel to approve the high bids of \$777.00 for walk in freezer and \$777.00 for walk in cooler from Glenn Smith and a high bid of \$500.00 for smaller white walk in cooler from Clayton and Holly Whitney. It was moved by VanDerWerff and seconded by Sinclair to go into executive session at 5:55pm for the purpose of student issues. Yes: All present. Motion carried.
