Superintendent Anderson stated that she signed off on the remodel and building project. There will be a year warranty with the project. There has been communication with CO-OP Architecture about the kitchen remodel project. CE Construction has been contacted about some issues with the roof and gutters. A representative from the roofing company was at the school to look at the issues. The car that the school purchased from CORE has been received. There will be an in person Title I review at a time to be determined.

Principal Determan reported that he along with four other teachers went to an artificial intelligence training in Chamberlain. Determan gave a recap of what was learned at the training and is hoping to set up a time where the rest of the staff can be educated on artificial intelligence. Region cross country is at Burke on October 11th. Dig Pink Volleyball Night is on October 12th, with Gregory hosting Burke. The competitive cheer and dance showcase will October 16th in Gregory. First and second round of football playoffs are October 19th and 26th respectively. October 20th is the end of the first quarter as well as the State Cheer and Dance Competition in Sioux Falls. State cross country is October 21st in Sioux Falls. Parent/Teacher Conferences are October 27th from 3:00-8:30 pm. There will be an early dismissal that day at 1:30 pm. All State Chorus and Orchestra is in Rapid City on October 27th and 28th. First round of volleyball regions is October 30th, while the second round is October 31st. Region volleyball semifinals is November 2nd. Football semifinals is November 3rd. November 8th at 9:00 am will be the Veteran's Day Program in the high school gym. State football is November 9th in Vermillion. There will be no school on November 10th for observance of Veteran's Day.
